Thursday November 24th and Friday November 25th the Dutch Physiologists Symposium will be held in Berg and Dal. The subject of this years meeting is “healthy aging”. During these two days, Young Physiologists can present their data and a workshop will be given. The meeting provides the ideal podium for achieving expertise in presentation of your research data, either as an oral or a poster presentation. This year, both days will contain presentations of Young Physiologists combined with presentations of keynote speakers from the Netherlands.

Both oral and poster sessions are connected to an Award competition. They will be in English; oral presentations will take 15 minutes each at maximum (10 minutes presentation + 5 minutes discussion). The best oral presenter and the best poster presenter will be awarded with €450,- to be spend on study tours. In this respect, Young Physiologists are considered to be PhD students and starting Post docs.

On Thursday at 10.30, there will be a workshop for Young Physiologists by dr. Josien van 't Klooster about “How to be succesfull in Brussels”.
